Bible Story - God's Dysfunctional Family - Stolen Blessing
Genesis 27:1-40

Questions for all ages

1. Jacob and Esau were brothers, but they were very different. Talk about the differences in your family.
2. Everyone in today's Bible story either wanted the wrong things or tried to get good things the wrong way. Talk about times you have been tempted to do the same.

For older children add these questions

1. In what way is our family similar to Isaac and Rebekah's? What can we learn from their example?
2. How can the truth that God is always working out His plan help our family face difficult times?
3. Is it reassuring to you to know that we can't get in the way of God's plan? Why or why not?
4. What are some ways our family can engage in God's mission to bless all people of the earth?

Family Challenge: Make a *Family Wants List* of things you all want for your family. Talk about how we can trust God to give us what we need and what is best for us. Pray for your family to trust God and be content with what you have.



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
