Bible Story - God's Covenant With Abraham
Genesis 22:1-14 & Hebrews 11:17-19

Questions for all ages

1. Sometimes it's hard to obey. Tell about a time when obeying was hard for you.
2. Abraham showed that he loved God most of all. What are some things you are tempted to love more than God?

For older children add these questions

1. What can our family learn from Abraham's story about obedience to God?
2. Like Abraham, we may not always know when we are being tested. Looking back, when has our family's faith been tested?
3. How can the testing of our faith strengthen our family relationship?
4. In what ways has our family become more obedient to Christ as a result of our faith being tested?

Family Challenge: Parents, a great way to teach this lesson is to lead your child to give away a favorite possession, like a toy. Then replace the item so they don't have to give it up. Talk about how Abraham was willing to give up Isaac, but God provided a sheep instead.



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
